

## Preliminary Bibliography on Patristic Research in Contemporary China

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It goes without saying that this bibliography does not claim to be exhaustive, and for that reason it is only a “preliminary bibliography.” General presentations of Christianity and encyclopaedias on Christianity, which contain some entries about patristics and the church fathers have not been considered here.

The following list of references is arranged by the authors’ names in alphabetical order; among the works belonging to the same author, the order is determined by the year of publication. Material inside each section is divided between a) translations from ancient and modern Western languages into Chinese, and b) original works in Chinese (books, monographs, articles).
